SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SPEAKER BROMM: ...you know, I think that's a process that's followed except it's just not always put in writing.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Well, yeah, you hold a hearing. You hear the information being presented, but...so what you're saying is, to answer their question, a majority vote of the board of commissioners if you're in county where the planning commission makes the recommendation on the permit to the board. The board would have a majority vote to agree to the statement of findings that would be presented.

SPEAKER BROMM: Correct.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Could be an interesting process, I guess. But, okay, that would answer that question for them. They didn't think that was in the law; that it was clear that that's how that would happen. Do you feel a need for...

SENATOR THOMPSON: In...

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...in this, in this, in the...

SPEAKER BROMM: Amendment, or in the green?

SENATOR THOMPSON: No, this is on page 6, subsection (6) of...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...the other amendment I think. Thank you.
