You got through it and you did it, I think, with good discussion throughout. And next week, Monday, we will not go right to the revenue bills, but Tuesday we plan to do that. And to the extent that we need time next week to go to revenue, Wednesday or Thursday we'll try to do that. It would be my hope, in looking at the calendar, that the following week we could get back to appropriations very early the following week and start to make this thing come together, as we all want to do. So again, thanks very much for the hard work. We didn't have any problems keeping people here and working through it. So have a good weekend a safe trip home.
