a different committee. And as I looked at the green copy and saw the language, the green copy was different, of course, but it did apply to agricultural operations and not all types of special permits. So we're getting the bill back to the original intent, restricting it to livestock operations. I would hope that that would be agreeable to most people. I think it is what I would like to do. So I would ask for your support for the amendment. And certainly, if there are questions, I'd be glad to try to answer them.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. You've heard the opening on AM1694. Open for discussion on that amendment to LB 754. Senator Preister, followed by Senator Burling.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. As I understand what you said, Senator Bromm, this does make sure that the application is only for the livestock waste facilities, that it doesn't apply to all of the other special use permits that the counties would be dealing with. Is that accurate? If I could ask...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR PREISTER: ...Senator Bromm a question, Mr. President?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Will you yield, Senator Bromm?

SPEAKER BROMM: Yes, Senator Preister, that is exactly right. That is...the language says that, and that would be our intent as well.

SENATOR PREISTER: Okay. Because I did hear more from both of my counties again...

SPEAKER BROMM: Sure.

SENATOR PREISTER: ...that the additional workload, the potential for court challenges, was a concern. So I appreciate that you recognize that, and that you put the amendment together. Thank you, Senator Bromm.
