SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator McDonald. Senator Hartnett, on the Bromm amendment.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Bromm, could I ask you a question?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, would you respond?

SPEAKER BROMM: Yes.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I'm just looking at your amendment here, and I think I will support it. You see a county like the county that I represent having to write something specified? Or do you think they have zoning laws right now that would be...take care of it? I...I'm just...you know, I just glanced at it now, your...

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator,...

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...amendment, and I haven't gotten a printout yet of it. So Senator Bromm, if, maybe, respond?

SPEAKER BROMM: Yes. Thank you. Senator Hartnett, the counties that have an area designated for agricultural or, lots of times referred to as A-1, the zoning ordinances, at least, that we've seen in those areas specify conditional uses. And generally one of those would be livestock operations. That is in those counties that have agricultural zoned land. I would assume your county has some of that, I would think. And so we'd have to look at your ordinance, but I would think that it would be applicable as it stands. It's not our intent to cause anyone to change their zoning ordinance. So that's...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay.

SPEAKER BROMM: ...my response.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, that's...yeah, I wanted something kind of on the record, Senator Bromm.

SPEAKER BROMM: Sure.
