SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You're...and you follow...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator McDonald, thank you, but I think I'll yield back the time and start at the beginning when I can have five minutes. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuthman.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I have not commented on this bill or this amendment. I did not comment the other day on it. The thing that I've got a real concern with is that everyone is saying, you know, we don't want to allow these big operations in, we want to continually try to help support the little one. But I would like to address one question to Senator Bromm.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, would you yield to a question?

SPEAKER BROMM: Yes I would.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Is there anything in this bill that states about anything with size, or has to do with anything about size, whether you're 100 head, or 5,000, or 50,000, or anything to do with that? Is there anything that relates to mega herds?

SPEAKER BROMM: No. No.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Thank you. That's all the answer I needed there. And I would also like to direct that same question to Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, do you yield?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes I do.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: I would repeat the question. Is there anything in this bill or your amendment that relates to size of any operation?
