SENATOR JONES: I don't have that with me.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jones, would you respond?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You don't have that?

SENATOR JONES: I don't have it right in front of me, no.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, then I won't ask you this question. It would be unfair. I'm going to read what I was going to ask Senator Jones. On page 1, starting in line 9 of Senator Bromm's amendment: "Such special conditions or requirements to be imposed may include, but are not limited to, the submission of information that may be separately provided to state or federal agencies in applying to obtain the applicable state and federal permits." If that information may be included but it need not be included, if other things may be included but need not be included, why do we put this language in the amendment? I will now ask Senator Bromm.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, would you respond?

SPEAKER BROMM: I will if I...certainly, but I am not sure I understand the question. I don't...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. My question is, why do we need any of this language in your amendment, beginning with "Such" on line 9, and ending with "permits" in line 13? That material is dealing with permissive language.

SPEAKER BROMM: Well, I think Senator Beutler and others wanted that on General File, and we rewrote the amendment to accommodate that request and that concern.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SPEAKER BROMM: And so that was not my idea to begin with.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then let me see if I can find something that was your idea.
