SPEAKER BROMM: You mean in any county, whether they have zoning or not?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Zoning or not.

SPEAKER BROMM: Correct.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Okay, thank you, those are the comments that I had. So I think I'm going to support this now. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuthman. Senator Chambers, there are no further lights on. He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is the adoption of amendment, FA1348, to LB 754. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the adoption of FA1348 offered by Senator Chambers to LB 754. Have you all voted who wish to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item to...

CLERK: Senator Chambers would move to amend with AM1349, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal page 1594.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on FA1349.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I'm working so hard on this bill I'm growing weary, but this is the last amendment that I have. On page 1, in line 20, I would strike the word "that," insert the word "whether," and on that same line, number 20, I would strike the word "not." And I will tell you why that's being done.
