legislation references somatic cell nuclear transfer, so that it's clear that the nucleus is transferred, rather than this much broader language of introducing nuclear material from one or more somatic cells into a fertilized or unfertilized egg, oocyte. And I believe that this particular definition is much more far-reaching, without even getting into any of the discussions about therapeutic versus reproductive. I believe that with this language, we are talking about not just being...putting the state on record as being against cloning, quote-unquote; but against any sort of genetic therapy that could be very clearly to the benefit of the embryo. And that was one of the criteria that was set forth by one of the earlier speakers, that their reason for being against the Schimek amendment, because they didn't feel that it was to the benefit of the embryo. Well, in this case, what I'm talking about is most definitely to the benefit of the embryo. And I believe that we would be putting the state in the position of not being able to allow...
