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football. But although this can be a spectator sport at times, I hope we don't go there. I do want to address the dialogue between Senator Brown and Senator Thompson on the genetic issue. In line 18, page 1 of AM0971, commonly referred to as the committee amendments, it says, "Human cloning means human asexual reproduction accomplished by"...and so forth. It does not say genetic therapy accomplished by...so forth. It says that human asexual reproduction. So it is defined there. Senator Bourne, he mentions some concerns with defining "product," or defining other words there. And I do defer to the Judiciary Committee on this issue. There were some concerns that...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SMITH: ...this may not be...or, this wasn't tight enough. But I deferred to the Judiciary Committee, that is very familiar with criminal code, for the wording there. And I have supported that, the Judiciary Committee language, because of that. Does that answer your questions? If you'd...I'm next on the speaking agenda, if you would like to respond at all.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: Well, I guess, quite honestly, Senator Smith, I don't know how to respond. I don't know if it clarifies it. You know, I do realize that a criminal statute needs to be very specific, and there cannot be any guesswork whatsoever as to what a term might mean. And while a Class IV felony is...you know, it's five years in prison and/or a \$10,000 fine, that's not insignificant. And as Senator Thompson mentioned, if...and again, I'm not trying to be difficult, because as you know, I did sign on to the bill. But I do think we have an obligation to make it as good a bill as possible. And as Senator Thompson mentioned, if...say, if this research is being done in the state of Washington or somewhere else, and somehow an individual from Nebraska has benefited by this, is that a delivery? Or is that a derive? You know, I'm using it in the wrong context, but it says, no person shall knowingly derive any product from human cloning, or deliver or receive such product. So does that mean that the doctor cannot deliver it to the patient, or receive it
