from someone who manufactured it? And again, you know, it does matter that...with criminal statutes, that it's precise and specific.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, we're one minute into your time.

SENATOR SMITH: I'm sorry?

SENATOR CUDABACK: We're one minute into your time.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you. The...when you say deliver or receive the product, I mean, we're talking about, in line 7, page 2 of the bill, deliver or receive any embryo produced by or from human cloning. It doesn't say that anyone is prohibited from delivering or receiving a cure. It merely says that no one can deliver or receive an embryo that was produced from cloning, human cloning, let me add. This does not impede the research, as flawed as it might be, on Dolly the sheep. This bill has nothing to do with that. This bill has nothing to do with impeding genetic therapy either.

SENATOR BOURNE: Well, Senator Smith, if I could interrupt for just a second, it says, the committee amendment, on line 6, it would be page 2, it says, "Derive any product from human cloning." I look up the word "derive," and that means to convey from one to another, as by transmission, descent, to transmit, impart, communicate, pass on, or hand on. So are there any other...do we know what it means...I mean, what product might be developed from this cloning? Do you see what I'm asking you?

SENATOR SMITH: I see where you're going. And I don't mean to be disrespectful. But some people disagree what the word "is" means. (Laugh)

SENATOR BOURNE: Well,...

SENATOR SMITH: And if we went through every single word here, we could be here for days.

SENATOR BOURNE: I don't disagree with that whatsoever. I don't
