books, unless we do something about it. So the program is right now on the books, ready to be implemented. However, we have a provision that in fact throws back...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR LANDIS: ...the childcare tax credit idea to the end of the out biennium, to the end of the out biennium...let me turn on my light here...and that is 2007. This is now expected, under the green sheet, under the A bill, under the legislative fiscal analysis, to cost \$1.9 million a year. So there's about \$3.8 million a year in this biennium and another \$3.8 million in the out biennium involved in that. We've never begun the program and at this point it would be essentially new spending. The bill was originally mine, and I'm willing to put it off. It's a good idea, but we need to put it off until we have money. To put it off, however, and to do that in a timely fashion, we need to find a 33-vote vehicle, and the only possibility, although I'd have to say this morning shows that maybe it's not a...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Sorry about that.

SENATOR LANDIS: Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kruse, on the motion to reconsider.

SENATOR KRUSE: Mr. President and members, this motion is incredible. As I understand it, we have tentatively decided that we could raise tax on a can of beer about one cent, and now we have a motion that that is way too much--one cent, after 16 years, added to a can of beer; one cent added to a product that has gone up many cents and dimes itself in its cost during that time. Are we...and we're to do this because, I understand, because those who sell it have voted that we...that's as high as we should go, is a half a cent. I'm wondering if we're setting a precedent here and if, in our broadening of the tax base, we're going to wait for a vote of the building trade before we go up 5 cents on a dollar, or those that produce software 5 cents on a dollar. And I think one member of the floor might want to reconsider a motion to raise cleaning services by
