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LB 285

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...for Final Reading as soon as possible, and sent over to the Governor?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, would you respond?

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Beutler, all things being equal, I would say yes. I would want to discuss the timing of that with Senator Brashear, and all of the rest of you, for that matter. But if that seems to be the thing that we would like to do and Senator Brashear would like to do, I would certainly try to facilitate that. And that's as good an answer as I can give you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you, Senator Bromm. For myself, if we're going to deal first with Senator Brashear's bill, I want to know ultimately how much revenue we get out of that bill, before we deal in a final manner with LB 285. And so the timing of all this seems extremely important to me. And I hope we'll all be conscious of that as we proceed...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...through this process.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Further discussion on the Beutler amendment? Senator Schimek, followed by Senator Brashear and others.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes. Thank you, Mr. Chairman and members. I haven't said anything today. For one, I'm trying to save my voice a little bit. You'll all be thrilled to know that I'm losing my voice. (Laugh) But I also have just been listening and thinking about this. And I want to follow up on Senator Beutler's questions, because, Senator Landis, I'm not quite certain what I heard you say. And if I could ask you a question?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, would you respond?

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes.
