SENATOR STUHR: That's what...I believe that's what our intent is, yes. I will...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR STUHR: My legal counsel is across by you. (Laugh)  
So...and so...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Let me check with him on...

SENATOR STUHR: All right. Yes. But...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...on these details. But are we...?

SENATOR STUHR: So...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Under the Brashear amendment, it looks like the increased contribution from the judges in the first year is 292, and in the second year is 389. Right?

SENATOR STUHR: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And the new programs that are put into place cost \$792,000 each year. Right?

SENATOR STUHR: Actually, as I was saying, between real dollars, the real dollars, the cost will \$92,000, because we're delaying the 50 percent joint and survivor benefit. But we have to...we put down the \$700,000 because actuarially you have to plan accordingly.

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR STUHR: You have to take into account, even though the benefit does not begin.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.
