SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good afternoon. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our afternoon session is about ready to reconvene. Senators, please check in.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, do you have any announcements or reports?

CLERK: I have nothing at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. Mr. Clerk, where were we when we recessed for lunch?

CLERK: LB 287, Mr. President. The next amendment to the bill, Senator Kremer would move to amend, AM1746. (Legislative Journal page 1669.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kremer, you're recognized to open on your amendment to LB 287, your amendment number AM1746.

SENATOR KREMER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. This amendment accomplishes what we've been talking about, which puts sales tax on labor for machinery repairs on agriculture machinery. It is, page 5, line 15, it strikes the new matter. In other...it strikes out...yeah, or...or repair parts. So when it takes out that, it would be subject to the sales tax repairs if it's on the repair part. That would take that out. So it only says that if the machine is subject to sales tax on the original purpose, the original purchase, then it would be subject to sales tax on the labor for repairs. If it's not subject to sales tax, then it would not be...on the original purchase, then it would not be subject to sales tax on the repair labor. I think that explains it. It's pretty simple. And with that, I'd ask you to support AM1746. Thank you.
