voted who care to? Senator Landis, what...have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 12 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 287 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill is LB 283. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time on January 13, referred to the Revenue Committee. That committee reported the bill to General File, with committee amendments attached. Those amendments were considered by the body. A motion to adopt failed, followed by a reconsideration, at which time the committee amendments were adopted. Then Senator Beutler moved to indefinitely postpone the bill. That did lay the bill over, at the request of the introducer.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, what...would you like to give us just a brief summary of where we are on the bill? Senator Landis, would you give us a brief summary where we are on the bill?

SENATOR LANDIS: We, I think, have adopted some committee amendments, if we had them. And I think we're now facing a series of amendments offered by Senator Chambers, as I recall.

SENATOR CUDABACK: That's fine. Thank you. Senator Beutler, we're now on your motion to indefinitely postpone. Did you...we are on your motion.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Did I what?

SENATOR CUDABACK: To indefinitely postpone. Do you wish to speak to it?

SENATOR BEUTLER: No, I wish to withdraw it, Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next item.
