because so many individuals, so much equipment is involved, that even if they were not confronting an enemy who is hostile and doing all it can to prevent from taking place what the plan is designed to accomplish, it would be hard to move that much person power and materiel in the way that the plan calls for. So I'm going to stay on this bill for awhile and talk about it, and talk about alcohol and the problems of alcohol. There's a person who had a lot of respect for me. And this person had a drinking problem. And this person went into a rehab program. And when the people running that program found out how much this person respected me, I received a call from that rehab operation. And you know what they told me? They said, Mr. Chambers, this person respects you a great deal, and here's what we would like you to do. I said, first of all, why are you asking me to do anything? I was told by this person that it's a part of their treatment, and if I would do what they asked me to do, it would facilitate the person successfully completing that treatment, which meant the person would have a good chance to kick the alcohol addiction. So I said, tell me then what it is, and I'll let you know what my response is. This is what those people who are supposed to be sensitive and understanding told me. We want you to talk to this person and say how much contempt you have for this person, how little respect you have for this person, and how you think this person is worthless because this person will not kick the habit. And I cut them off there. I said, I thought when you called me you started by saying that this person respects me. The person said, yeah, that's what we said. I said and you said that you want me to say all these terrible things to this person who respects me. Why do you want me to do that? I was told that if I were to say this, it would completely break the person down. It would crack the ego, break the will and leave that person vulnerable so that this treatment could take effect. I said, woman, you must be crazy. I will never do anything like this. Somebody who is respecting me and might be hanging onto sanity by a fingernail and you want me to clip that fingernail. I don't even want to talk to you anymore. And that terminated the conversation. That might be one of the reasons, if such represents the philosophy, why some of these so-called rehab programs don't work. Maybe all of these rehab programs are experiments, and nobody is sure what will work. But one thing that outfit knows,
