

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE
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FLOOR DEBATE

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LB 283, 598

Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. Members, please report to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Chambers, did you request a roll call vote?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SPEAKER BROMM: Regular order?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SPEAKER BROMM: All members are...I'm sorry, we're missing Senator Bourne. Senator Chambers says we may proceed. Mr. Clerk, if you would call the roll in regular order, please. I'm sorry. Let me announce what we're voting on. And I apologize for not doing that. This is on Senator Chambers' reconsideration motion, which he closed on. And so this will be a vote whether to reconsider the vote on FA1351.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1674.)
3 ayes, 39 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to reconsider.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is not successful, and I do raise the call. But at this time, members, I would like to announce that we do have on the agenda the 2003 Executive Board committee priority bill, LB 598. And I think we'll go ahead and move to that at this time. After that, we'll see whether we come back to LB 283 or the next bill, which will be LB 540. So at this time, Mr. Clerk, unless you have other messages or announcements, we will go to LB 598.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 598, a bill by Senator Tyson and others. (Read title.) The bill, when introduced, was referred to the Executive Board. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Engel. No, I'm sorry. It would be...
