off the idea of term limits. There are only three other states in the Midwest that have term limits. That's Michigan, Ohio, and South Dakota. That's four states out of the 11. And when you think about some of the organizational kinds of things that legislators participate in, we are going to be really handicapped to be term limited, I believe. One of the things that we're going to do this year is try to bring the Council of State Governments annual meeting to Nebraska in 2007 or 2008. But you realize what a problem that sometimes is, because the people who may try to bring something in may not be here when it really occurs. And that can be a handicap. If you have...let's say that Nebraska did get the conference in 2008. You would have...half the Legislature would already be brand new, and you would have the other half...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...leaving, and probably wouldn't be interested.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen and Senator Schimek. Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. President and members of the body, I want to stand up and comment a little bit and support this constitutional amendment. I serve on the Exec Board, and we had a good long discussion on how to try to figure out how to do this. And they mentioned about the time that we could get it on the ballot, and whether it would be too quick, or whether people was really soaked in to what really is happening here if we put it on too quick. But I still think that we need to work on this and try to figure out how to get it on next year. Somebody said something about having it on the primary. That takes 40 votes to put it on the primary. And I would think that would be possible amongst this floor. And it's been mentioned several other times about we being a unicameral. As far as I'm concerned, out of all the states in the union, we're the worst one to have term limits in our constitution, simply because we cannot move back and forth. And I think that term limits is, of course, at the ballot box. But this...we're just asking the people to reconsider their last vote that they made on this
