of commerces around the state that are interested in doing that. So why are we doing their work for them? Let's let this play out and see if they'll do it for us, and then it won't look so self-serving. So I say, the public imposed this, maybe we should not try and undo that. Let them try and undo it if there's such an outcry about term limits being bad. And I must say, finally, the really scary thing about term limits, as I look at Senator Mines up there, in six years, if term limits aren't overthrown, he could be the Speaker of this Legislature, so. (Laughter) So that's...I'm just having fun, Senator Mines. Don't take that seriously. So I do think there would be a very big void in, not necessarily leadership, but experience. There's a lot of leadership experience in this body. And some of you are very capable. Some more than others, of course, and we all do our judgments there. But before you're ready to lead a body of this size, boy, it's good to be around four or six years first, whether in a...whether you're a committee chairman or whether you're chairman of the Exec Board. I'd have paid to see Senator Engel be chair of the Exec Board his first year here. He'd have been...he's lost enough now, the way it is. But if he'd have been the chair of the Exec Board his first year here,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...he'd have been asking a lot of questions. And we wouldn't have known him. Now we know him, and we trust him. So I hope you are listening to what I have to say. I'm a little confused. I'm cynical. I'm upset with the public for imposing it. I don't want to be self-serving. I've said to myself, I'm very content to serve out this term and not run again, whether term limits are overturned or not. So do your will. I think for right now I'm going to vote red. Hope you don't hold that against me. I think the 12-year was a nice compromise. But I do think it would be more effective if there's some chamber of commerces in this state, and if the publicity about this would be generated not from within here, but from without, I think it would be much better chance of overturning term limits. If we do it, it looks very self-serving. And so with that, I'll give the rest of my time back to the Chair.
