SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Tyson, would you respond?

SENATOR TYSON: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Senator Tyson, I'm aware that we now have term limits for legislators. There's term limits for Governor. Are there any other instances of term limits?

SENATOR TYSON: I...

SENATOR RAIKES: I'm hearing...

SENATOR TYSON: ...I believe. Yeah.

SENATOR RAIKES: Any instances you know of, of term limits with local government?

SENATOR TYSON: No, I don't believe there is any.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay.

SENATOR TYSON: Certainly not in the State Constitution.

SENATOR RAIKES: My question for you then is...and it's been mentioned several times that this appears self-serving. Did you consider, in your bill, eliminating term limits not only for legislators but for the Governor and for the State Treasurer?
