LB 208, 285, 320, 540, 574A, 598, 754, 759A

CLERK: Nothing further Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of the bill itself, advancement of LB 598, E & R Initial. Seeing no lights on, Senator Tyson. He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is, shall LB 598 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the advancement of LB 598. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 598.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to advance was successful. We will now move to Select File, special order. There are...are there any items, Mr. Clerk, for the record?

CLERK: Yes, I do, Mr. President. Enrollment and Review reports LB 285 and LB 320 to Select File; LB 574A, LB 759A to Select File. Senator Kruse has an amendment to LB 208 to be printed; Senator Synowiecki, LB 208; Senator McDonald, a series of amendments of LB 754; Senator Foley to LB 208. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1675-1677.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk, first item on LB 540.

CLERK: Senator Mossey, I have Enrollment and Review amendments first of all, Senator. (AM7116, Legislative Journal page 1495.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 540.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Bourne would move to amend, AM1616. (Legislative Journal page 1584.)
