LB 285A, 320, 320A

CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal page 1684.) 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Education Committee confirmation report.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to adopt was successful. We now move on to General File appropriation bills. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, two A bills. The first, Senator Stuhr offers LB 320A. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuhr, you're recognized to open on LB 320A.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. With the passage of the Brashear amendment to LB 320, it is estimated that there will be costs involved in changing the automatic system to accommodate the proposed changes in the judges' retirement plan. This A bill proposes that \$63,360 be appropriated from the Nebraska Judges Retirement Act Expense Fund in 2003 and '04 to the Nebraska Public Employees Retirement Board to aid in carrying out the provisions of LB 320. I want to point out that this has no impact on the General Fund. With that, I ask for your support. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. You've heard the opening on LB 320A. Open for discussion on that motion. Senator Stuhr, there are no senators wishing to speak. She waives the opportunity close. The question before the body is advancing LB 320A to E & R Initial. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. Motion before us is advancing LB 320A to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 320A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to advance was successful. Mr. Clerk, next LB. The next LB is LB 285A. Is anybody present to...here comes Senator Landis. Thank you.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 285A by Senator Landis. (Read title.)
