amendment is adopted. And they are...the projections set forth in the fiscal note are at the 5 percent rate, as LB 759 was originally filed in the green copy. If you will turn to the salmon colored sheet which has been handed out to you...and if you don't have one, please let us know and we'll get you one. The salmon colored sheet shows by grouping everything that would be included within LB 759, and projects the revenue, premised upon the 5.5 percent rate. With that, I would urge your consideration and discussion and adoption of AM1785. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Beutler...or, Senator Brashear. Senator Beutler, you're next.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Brashear, let me ask a couple questions, so I start to get the dimensions of this right. First of all, the salmon colored sheet, and the figures on the salmon colored sheet, take into account the technical changes in Senator Landis' amendment, as well as the changes in your two amendments,...

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...two proposed amendments to AM1745. Is that accurate?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: That is correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And is it your position that your...you will fight any reductions in any of these amounts? I mean, you have...have you accepted any amendments to this that would reduce revenue from anybody? Or intend to vote for any reductions in this total amount?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Well, Senator Beutler, there are always discussions on the floor, as you know, of things that people like and don't like. It is my official posture as I stand here to indicate to you that I intend to resist reductions in this...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Let me...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: ...in the bill.
