in favor of the amendment, if each one of them would start their speech by saying that tax or alternative revenue that they would like to see replace this \$56 million. For myself, I feel flexible in terms of trying to look at different revenue sources and come up with some package that most of us would consider fair, but I certainly, for one at least, need to hear from you what it is that you would...what \$56 million chunk or thereabouts you think would be a good replacement for this. I know a number of the people who stood up and said that they don't like this particular one were people who are adamantly against an income tax. Now we can make this up with income tax. Senator Hartnett's bill is worth \$92 million. That's a possibility, but I hope you know where you're going.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And obviously, if we start going in that direction, the lobby is going to come in here, the Omaha Chamber of Commerce is going to come rushing in. And I know some of you don't want to do the income tax and, yet, you're arguing against this. Well, what is it that you would like to do? I hope everybody who speaks will say what alternative source of revenue they would prefer. That would help us develop a consensus. Thank you.
