SENATOR CUDABACK: Been a request for a machine vote. The question before the body is adoption of AM1644 to LB 759. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk. Record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1716.)
16 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was not successful. I do raise the call. Next agenda item. Mr. Clerk, do you have anything for the items first for the record? Okay. Thank you. It is 1:00. As agenda states, Final Reading. Members, please take your seats. As you know, we are on Final Reading. Unauthorized staff people please leave the floor. Thank you. We are on Final Reading. First vote to be taken, to suspend the at-large reading, according to Rule 6, Section 8. Mr. Clerk, read the bill, please...number of the bill, please. LB 143. First motion will be to suspend the rules, according to Rule 6, Section 8. All in favor of the vote, vote aye, and opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Mr. Clerk, read the title.
