LB 143, 143A, 160

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 143 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1717.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 143 passes. Mr. Clerk, next bill.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the first item on LB 143A is a motion by Senator Connealy, but I have a note he wishes to withdraw.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Is that correct? It is withdrawn.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 143A on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 143A pass? All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1718.) Vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 143A passes. Mr. Clerk, next bill.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 160, the first vote would be to approve the dispensing of the reading at large of LB 160.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion before the body is suspend the at-large reading, according to Rule 6, Section 8. All in favor of that motion vote aye, and opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Vote is 39 ayes, 2 nays to dispense with the reading at large, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Mr. Clerk, read
