SENATOR THOMPSON: ...sort out some things in the amendment.

SENATOR ERDMAN: I would, Mr. President.

SENATOR THOMPSON: And I have to admit I'm one of the detail people here, so.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Sure.

SENATOR THOMPSON: You said there was only one difference?

SENATOR ERDMAN: One thing that wasn't included in either of the preliminary, the final, or the Governor's idea...

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay.

SENATOR ERDMAN: ...that didn't have a hearing.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay.

SENATOR ERDMAN: I can show you exactly where that is and I can give you the rationale,...

SENATOR THOMPSON: All right.

SENATOR ERDMAN: ...but this is your time.

SENATOR THOMPSON: And that...and then the other things, for example, the things you have listed as other on Health and Human Services and Finance that aren't...are neither the Governor's nor...

SENATOR ERDMAN: Those were taking...those were deducted, if you will, from the discussions the committee had about 12 percent reduction in administration or those ideas had been discussed in the committee, based on what I read in your proposal.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR ERDMAN: You bet.
