It's office rental and it's paying the mileage for them to visit their clients and travel from city to city, not just be in their hub city but also to get out to the areas in the district. These are the front-line people. They are in Agency 25. A lot of these are going to be child protective service workers. In...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...Agency 26, these are the Finance and Support people and you will see a lot of those folks in Lincoln, but they're also in the districts, and they file the federal claims, they collect the reporting information that we have to have for the federal government so that we are not in...so that we stay in compliance and we get that federal match to the money that we have to serve Nebraskans. They are the finance direct-line workers. These aren't people lounging around in big offices thinking about things. These are...these will be very, very serious cuts in terms of keeping Nebraska in compliance, making sure people are processed properly so we don't have a lot of errors and people who are proclaimed eligible who may not be eligible who we'll lose funding for later. They are the front-line workers in Health and Human Services who are working in your communities for the safety of the elderly, for children and people with disabilities. There are only a few. It would be Ross and...
