And I think we did a lot this afternoon by just talking about this, and maybe come up with some ideas for individual senators to introduce something then. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jones. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Call the question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do see five hands. The question before the body is, shall debate cease on AM1763? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on ceasing debate on the Erdman amendment to LB 407. Have you all voted who care to? We're voting on ceasing debate. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to cease debate was successful. Senator Erdman, you're recognized to close on AM1763 to LB 407.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you Mr. President. I'd ask for a call of the house, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Erdman, you may proceed to close, if you care to.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. I will do that as members are arriving. First of all, let me say to the body, thank you for your indulgence today. But most importantly, I
