SENATOR RAIKES: Mr. President, I would ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. The house is under call. Senators, please check in. Senator Janssen, Senator Johnson, Senators Hudkins, Mossey, Jones, Friend, Stuhr, Landis, Loudon, Cunningham, McDonald, Senators Hartnett, Quandahl, Kremer, Senator Maxwell, Tyson, and Connealy. Senator Brashear, would you check in, please? Senator Schrock, Senator Kremer. The house is under call. Senators, please check in. Senator Maxwell. Senator Tyson, would you check in, please? Senator Tyson? Senator Tyson, the house is under call. Would you check in, please? Thank you. And Senator Maxwell. Senator Beutler, would you authorize call-in votes, or did you, rather? Senator Beutler, did you authorize call-in votes?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Call-in votes will be fine.

SENATOR CUDABACK: And we are doing the ceasing debate on AM1802. There's been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, call the roll, please. We are voting on whether to cease debate on AM1802, offered by Senator Raikes to LB 407. Mr. Clerk, call the roll, please.
