CLERK: Senator Wehrbein would move to amend his amendment with AM1860. (Legislative Journal pages 1760-1761.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein, to open on your amendment to the amendment to LB 407.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Mr. President. This is what I have fore mentioned. The original amendment said \$25,000. We found out yesterday, I guess it was, that they would like to increase that Cash Fund authority to \$50,000. Having access to some private funds, they would like authority to spend them, and that's simply what this does, Status of Women.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. You've heard the opening on AM1860, which is an amendment to AM1751 to LB 407. Open for discussion on AM1860. Seeing no lights on, Senator Wehrbein. He waives the opportunity. Question before the body is adoption of AM1860 to AM1751. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on AM1860, which is an amendment to AM1751. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment to the amendment.
