SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Landis. Senator Stuthman, you're recognized.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR BAKER: The house is under call. All senators who are absent please report to the floor. Any unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Members, please check in. Senator Engel, Senator Brown, Senator Jones, Senator Quandahl, would you please check in. Senator Synowiecki. Senator Engel and Senator Synowiecki. Senator Engel and Senator Synowiecki. SENATOR MINES: Mr. President, could we accept call-in votes, please?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, we will accept call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Bourne, you had voted no, Senator. Senator Hartnett voting yes. Senator Aguilar voting yes. Senator Engel voting yes.

SENATOR BAKER: Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President to cease debate.
