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is just perfect right now, with the situation we've been going through these last couple of years, as far as examining our overall tax structure and both revenue and spending and our...and government as a whole. We're talking about downsizing government. We're talking about our spending issues. We're talking about our tax structure, and how antiquated we are in the state of Nebraska as far as our taxing policy, because we are about 30 years behind as far as where our revenue is coming from. Our economy has changed. It's changing, and it's changing every day, and it's going to continue to change. It's not going to be like it was 30 years ago. So I do believe this is very timely. And I do believe that if you get all these different parties together and look at all of the exemptions and the credits and other preferences...because we've talked about that so many times in the past. And when we talk about, I want...you know, I want this exempted because...and the criticism, there's too many exemptions over here. Well, I'd like to see them all laid out on the table of who's getting exemptions on this side of the table, who's getting exemptions on that side of the table, and put them all out there so that we can see where all these exemptions are going. And it's not all going to industry. It's not all going to ag. But there are many, many exemptions in all areas. So let's look at all of them and see which ones we think are fair and which are not fair, and how we can come up with a fairer tax system, and again, overall government, like we were talking today about downsizing government, and I mentioned that before here, and let's look at it all. But I think in the next six months, it's going to be a very busy six months to get this job done. I do agree with Senator Landis. He says as far as our committee hearings and so forth. I think many, many times that you get more done just by having different parties together all in the same room, and where you can bounce back and forth instead of just having testimony and then other testimony and other testimony, and you don't have the rebuttal. But I do believe the time is now. I'm glad he brought this up. And whoever is asked to serve on this, I hope they'll do it willingly. I know I certainly will. Thank you very much.
