that we need to change the course of here, so that we don't wind up completely off the road, in five years, that we want to be on? And so I'm not talking about hammering out or negotiating a deal between two groups. I'm talking about, what is the horizon that we're trying to keep our eyes on. If you've been a pilot, or if you're a pilot, it's analogous to keeping your eyes on the horizon as you fly the aircraft. Because if you don't, you're going to fly it into the ground. And that's what I'm talking about with this kind of a working group. And I truly wish that we had more time than we do have. But...and this will take some time if it's going to be meaningful. But I think that if we prioritize the work we do over the interim...we have no money to travel anyway. We should just as well be doing work like this, and impose upon our staff somewhat.
