SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...have they taken a cut other than...?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Not a cut. These next two years are flat. But not...no increase, but there's been no cut. And once again, if you...the increases over the years have been fairly modest to...well,...

SENATOR BOURNE: So...but again, there are no General Fund monies that go to the Department of Roads?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's correct.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. Well, let me...I have an amendment that's coming up. And a lot of people have been asking what my amendment is, and...because it's about \$6 million. And what it is, is that, as I understand it, the Department of Roads had asked to build a building, and the Appropriations Committee said no. And jump in and correct me if I'm wrong. And then, rather than putting the money into the state's General Fund, they put it back into the Department of Roads Fund.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: And as I understand it, it's not allocated, or...towards any projects. Is that...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's true.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...accurate? Now, can...and again, I realize that this is not the amendment. But quite honestly, I was surprised when I heard that there's no General Fund money that goes to the Department of Roads. I thought there was a General Fund appropriation. So can you help me out and say, what was the justification...I know I'm getting ahead of myself...but what was the justification for leaving the \$6 million in the Department of Roads budget rather than put it into the General Fund?
