transfers to balance over the last year. This year, Department of Insurance Cash Fund, Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund, Charitable Gaming Operations Fund, the Tobacco Products Administrative Cash Fund, the Motor Vehicle Licensing Board. We also did the Information Technology Infrastructure Fund, and Unclaimed Property Fund. We are taking funds that were dedicated all over the place. We've been referring to them as cookie jars. But they're no different than the Highway Cash Fund. They were all raised from users, perhaps, and others who...we took people who were licensing for professions. If there's a little bit of money buildup in those professional funds, we took it. We've taken everybody's but theirs. Senator Bromm said that this is going to set us back with our infrastructure. Well, I'm telling you, we are set back so far with our infrastructure, with what we have done in terms of our own capital construction needs, the building of our own buildings, the efforts that we need to make in terms of education and health and human services, and those structural infrastructure pieces. We aren't able to afford everything, and we're just asking everyone to share. Senator Baker said the Department of Roads had come in and they laid off all sorts of people and they were able to make better use of the funds. Well, my argument would be, then they found the money to do more with highway construction, because they aren't paying employees anymore, for whatever purposes that they were there. Now, maybe they're using those private contracts that some other senators worry about. But let's just say they laid off employees; they're more efficient. Then this money went to roads. So they should have more money to put into this than they did less. I don't know what they're doing with that money, but it would seem to me that if they have made that efficiency, then this isn't even a drop in terms of construction. This should be just even for two years. It isn't fair to all the other funds...and we had dozens of them here...that have been taken from other...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...user groups. It's not fair. I don't think we're breaking any faith. I think this is a problem that we have that people understand. And we're just asking to delay a couple of years a few projects. That's all it is. I'm going
