in their budget, regardless. This amendment is half of what the underlying amendment is. So regardless of how you feel about the underlying amendment, I would assume if you oppose that you'd want this on, because it cuts it in half. This is a 5 percent cut to the road operating budget only. There's still money in the Road Department fund from other aspects of the ways they get their aid and their operating budget together. So again, this amendment would take their budget from this year, 445 (sic--545), to 573, and would represent a cut of \$16.9 million, or 2.8 percent. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Thompson. You've heard the closing on FA1361, which is an amendment to AM1849 to LB 408. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. There's been a request for a record vote, but we do a machine vote. There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.
