SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was not successful. FA1361 has not been adopted. I do raise the call. Back to discussion of AM1849 itself. There were lights on. Senator Baker, yours is first. He waives the opportunity. Senator Janssen. He waives that opportunity. Senator Dwite Pedersen.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do see five hands. The question before the body is, shall debate cease on AM1849 to LB 408? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on ceasing debate on AM1849. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Debate does cease. Senator Thompson, you're recognized to close on AM1849 to LB 408.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you. I'd like to make sure that everyone checks in and we still have...otherwise I want a call of the house. Can we check in and see if everybody stayed on the floor?

SENATOR CUDABACK: You can request a check-in, but...are you requesting a call of the house?

SENATOR THOMPSON: I'll do just a call of the house.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 43 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Schimek, would
