keeping...maintaining contracts. And I'm going to just simply read it with the new language, so you understand it. Shall require the submission of each department and agency of the state of copies of all written contracts for acquisition, construction, repair, or remodeling, including federal contracts, before such contracts are executed by the executive officer of the state authorized to execute such contracts, and shall maintain copies of such contracts on file for inspection by the Legislative Fiscal Office...Analyst. And it simply keeps these contracts that we have. They are going to be accessible by our office, but they are not in the Fiscal Analyst's Office per se. They're located down the hallway, which has been traditional practice. It simply is an efficiency movement, not necessarily saving money, but it prevents duplication of effort. And it's a very simple little amendment. That's all I have, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. You've heard the opening on AM1711. Open for discussion on that amendment offered by Senator Wehrbein. There are no lights on, Senator Wehrbein. He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of AM1711, offered by Senator Wehrbein to LB 410. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of AM1711, offered by Senator Wehrbein to LB 410. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.
