LB 424, 798

Senator Brown does not wish to speak, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Beutler, there are no further lights on. Did you wish to close?

SENATOR BEUTLER: No. If there are no questions, I wouldn't take any more of the body's time. But thank you for the consideration. And I'm sorry for the abbreviated...or, the delayed discussion. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. You've heard the closing on AM1656, offered by Senator Beutler to LB 424. The question before the body is, should that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of the Beutler amendment, AM1656 to LB 424. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment was adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator Mossey.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 424 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is to advance LB 424 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced.

CLERK: Senator Mossey, LB 798. I do have E & R's first of all, Senator. (AM7128, Legislative Journal page 1603.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 798.
