LB 411

LB 411. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Jensen would move to amend with AM1888.
(Legislative Journal page 1827.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jensen, to open on AM1888 to LB 411.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This amendment was brought to us by the Dental Association to test the Chairman of the Health and Human Services Committee, to see if he could say "cranial birth defects affecting the occlusion." In seriousness, this is just a very small amendment that changes...on page 2, line 7, strikes cleft palate...or, excuse me, "cleft lip and palate," and insert the words "craniofacial birth defects affecting the occlusion." That's all it does. It helps...it clears up language and more correctly describes the procedure. I don't think there's any difference in that. But that's all the amendment does. I would just ask for its adoption. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jensen. You've heard the opening on AM1888. Now open for discussion on that motion. Seeing no lights on, Senator Jensen, did you wish...he waives the opportunity to close on AM1888. The question before the body is, shall AM1888 be adopted? All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of AM1888, offered by Senator Jensen to LB 411. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Jensen's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on LB 411, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Mossey, for a motion.
