CLERK: You would.

SENATOR BEUTLER: So I would do that, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: May I assume...

SPEAKER BROMM: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Excuse me, Mr. President. And, Senator, the other amendments you had filed earlier today, would most likely want to withdraw those?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would pull all other amendments.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler, Stuhr, Brashear, Chambers would move to amend with AM1943. (Legislative Journal page 1848.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Could I ask, Senator Beutler, is it your intent to open on this amendment?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'll say just a couple of words. And this was the work of several people, I don't know whose amendment it would be, so I'll say a couple of words, then yield my time to Senator Chambers and Senator Brashear and Senator Stuhr.

SPEAKER BROMM: You're recognized, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: As I understand the contents of the amendment, it would eliminate the two additional benefits, one of which was the spousal benefit and the other of which was the retirement, early retirement benefit. It would retain essentially all of the committee's work, that is the additional contribution by the judges as well as the \$3 court fee that was in the original bill, plus it would retain the \$1 additional court fee that, in fact, was part of Senator Brashear's amendment. And those are the elements of the amendment, as I understand it. And, Senator Brashear, did...I would yield my time to you and Senator Chambers and Senator Stuhr.
