CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor and unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Before we take call-in votes, we will let the people check in. Senator Dwite Pedersen, Senator Jensen, Senator Janssen, Senator Mossey. Senators Friend, Burling, Price, McDonald. Senator Maxwell.
