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I think with this those individuals are going to have to go through the process of filing that to the state, to the Department of Revenue, on the amount of sales tax on their labor for the project. And I think this situation is going to make those people take another look at whether they even want to do that. And I think we're going to be really telling some individuals that would like to earn a little bit more money that, you know, you have got to comply with this. And if you don't send the money in, you just as well forget about it. They don't want to go through that process. They've never done that before, and it's real hard for those individuals to send, you know, it in. It can be done. It very much well can be done, but the dollars are not going to be that great what they have to send in, but it's just the process of doing it. And I have a real concern with what we are going to be sending the message out to the people, not the contractors, but to the people that want to help themselves financially and want to help other people with small projects. I think we're going to eliminate that group of people from doing those jobs, and those jobs are not going to get done. And I have a real concern with this. It has been very well explained to me as far as the process of improving at 100 percent, or the contractor, anything to do on that. They have staff to file all this paperwork. These other individuals don't have the staff to do that. And what, in my opinion, they're going to quit doing that type of work or they are going to find some way around it so that they continue to do it. And I don't want to see them people doing that and having to have to get caught in the process and be fined because the fine would be way far greater than what they would ever make on doing some of these small projects for their neighbors and their friends. So with that, I will turn the balance of my time back to the Chair.
