LB 759

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brashear. You've heard the close on AM1939 offered by Senator Brashear to LB 759. The question before the body is, should that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on adoption of the Brashear amendment, AM1939, to LB 759. Have you all voted who care to? Senator Brashear, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President, I'd request a call of the house, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor, unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Janssen, Senator Mossey, Senator Jones, Senator Friend, Senator Quandahl, Senator Price, Senator Maxwell, and Senator Foley. Senator Chambers, the house is under call. Senator Quandahl, and Senator Foley, and Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers, the house is under call. Senator Brashear, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: I'd like to have a roll call vote, please.
