SENATOR KRUSE: My intentions are to withdraw this and I would do that at this time, Mr. President, if I could.

SPEAKER BROMM: I would yield to Senator Kruse for that purpose, if he would like. I yield the rest of my time to Senator Kruse.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You're giving your time to Senator Kruse. Senator Kruse, you have about four minutes.

SENATOR KRUSE: I don't need that. I request to withdraw this amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have, Senator Beutler, AM1598.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, to open on your amendment, AM1598.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And I'd withdraw that, Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Back to the bill, itself, Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President, I'd like to request a call of the house, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: This is not your closing. This is simply discussion. There were lights on, sorry, I did not make that clear. But your light was the first, so you may speak or let the next person speak.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: I'll pass.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, your light was on also. He waives. Senator Chambers. He waives also. Back to Senator
