SENATOR BEUTLER: Let me ask you again. Would you see any value to not going through all these...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...amendment processes on these bills and just advance this one to Select File without further amendment, and if we need to come back to it come back to it, and if we don't we don't, rather than spending additional hours here working our way through this bill?

SENATOR LANDIS: If we close on this amendment, vote on it, if there were no other amendments, I wouldn't offer any, I'd offer it to Select File. I don't...and I wouldn't...I have not asked the Speaker to put this on the schedule. Passing over it would make some sense until such time as we have clarity on LB 759. That would be acceptable to me. I don't have another amendment and we're in the middle of that one. I don't intend to withdraw it. But I think Senator Chambers has one. I think Senator Kruse wanted to offer one. But if they chose not to, that would be fine. I wouldn't ask to amend the bill. I'd move it to Select File, leave it there and wait for the dust to settle before I'd ever take it back up. I'm prepared to vote for LB 759, to pass it, and to override the veto, and I'll be happy to play that out.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Tyson, on AM1713.

SENATOR TYSON: A question for Senator Landis, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, would you respond?

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes.

SENATOR TYSON: And if you already answered this and I wasn't paying attention, my apologies, Senator Landis. But AM1713 was a bill, is that correct, because it was offered the other day
