under another guise.

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes, there was a bill.

SENATOR TYSON: Do you know the bill number?

SENATOR LANDIS: It had different provisions, but there was a bill on delaying the childcare tax credit. That's true.

SENATOR TYSON: No, I'm talking about AM1713, which is the...

SENATOR LANDIS: This amendment. Right?

SENATOR TYSON: ...death tax.

SENATOR LANDIS: Oh, that was not a bill. It was reported out...it is a bill. It was reported out by the Revenue Committee as a substitute body of language for a bill that was otherwise in there but didn't have it in originally. So, yes, you're right, it was a bill.

SENATOR TYSON: Okay. Do you have some idea what the fiscal note was?

SENATOR LANDIS: Eight hundred and eighty thousand dollars per year.

SENATOR TYSON: Per year?

SENATOR LANDIS: Um-hum.

SENATOR TYSON: Okay. Thank you very much. I'll return the balance of my time to the Chair.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Tyson. Senator Beutler, on AM1713.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Landis, could you go over what your amendment does now again? I'm sorry, now I'm paying attention to the amendment.
