SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 283 advances. Mr. Clerk, any items for the record?

CLERK: Amendments to LB 754, Mr. President, to be printed; study resolution LR 187 by Senator Quandahl, that will be referred to the board. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1873-1874.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Speaker Bromm, did you wish to speak?

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you very much, Senator Cudaback. Members, we do need to come back tomorrow, but you have done an awful lot of work this week and you've put us in a position where, hopefully, early next week we'll be able to make some final decisions on the pieces of the budget package and the money to pay for it. And so that will give us a chance to get at the Governor fairly soon, and we'll be able to perhaps do some other work; that we won't get to everything we'd like to this session, but we'll be able to do some other things. So I would move that we do adjourn until tomorrow, May 16, at 9:00 a.m.
