SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Janssen on the Chambers amendment.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. I was one of those people at that meeting last week. And I was, you know, I was kind of shocked about it. That's the second time this session that I've been in meetings with the administration about agricultural matters. But then to turn right around and make a complete circle and come back and say we don't need this commission anymore, it's kind of baffling to me that in one hand we need something, and in the other...in the next go-around, why, then we don't need something that helps agriculture in this state. And I think if you're going to support agriculture, you should support it all the way. And this commission was put in place several years ago for a purpose that is beneficial to agriculture in this state. And to blatantly see...say that it needs to go away without any funding just doesn't make sense to me. So, Senator Chambers, thank you for bringing us the opportunity to sometime yet this year be able to address this issue. Thank you.
